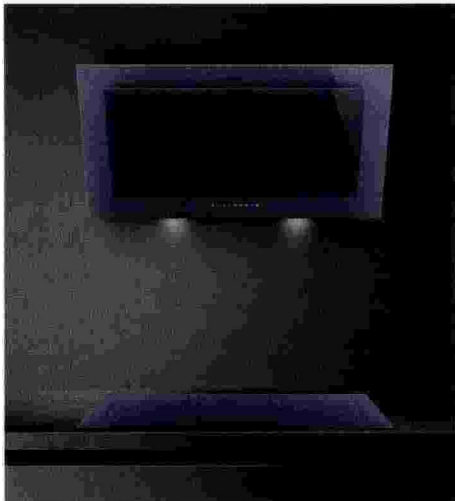
MODERN HISTORY
